

Kitchen Caddy Request Form



This project is funded by the Waste Authority through the Waste Avoidance and Resource Recovery Account

About 35% of Bunbury's general rubbish sent to landfill is food waste.

In line with the need to divert more waste away from landfill and remove food waste from the red lid landfill bin, City of Bunbury residents are eligible for one free Kitchen Caddy per household.

The City will also provide you with green compostable bags free of charge.

Please fill out your details in the space below and we will deliver a free Kitchen Caddy to your home.

The caddy includes a durable handle, which forms a locking lid.

This hinged snap fitting lid and locking mechanism, ensures that spillage is avoided and retains moisture to keep odours locked away. The curved design ensures easy cleaning and the unit is dishwasher safe.

Items that can go in your Kitchen Caddy include:

- Fruit and vegetable scraps
- Meat and bones
- Tea bags and coffee grinds
- Egg shells
- Dairy products
- Seafood
- Take away food and baked goods
- Cardboard and paper products, used tissues and paper towel



Once your Kitchen Caddy is full simply empty the contents, including the compostable bag into your Lime Green FOGO Bin. The organic waste collected is recycled and turned into a rich compost through the Banksia Road Composting Facility in Dardanup.
